Lifeline offers a monthly discount of up to \$19.25 on high-speed internet service for eligible low-income households. Eligibility includes households with incomes at or below 135% of federal poverty guidelines or those receiving benefits such as SNAP, Medicaid, and Supplemental Security Income.

By participating in the Oregon Lifeline Program, Alyrica Networks strives to bridge the digital divide, ensuring all residents have the opportunity to benefit from internet access. This initiative supports children in connecting to educational resources, adults in working from home and receiving medical care, and people in maintaining relationships despite distance.
