### A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AGE-FRIENDLY COMMUNITY

**WHEREAS**, as of 2025 Neilsberg Research Data shows Philomath, Oregon having 10.22% of our population being under the age of 15, 32.56% are 15 to 29 years of age, 40.94% are 30 to 64 years of age, and 16.28% of our community citizens are over 65 years of age.
